

# MICROSOFT SOFTWARE LICENSE TERMS

## SIMPLYGON TITLE EVALUATION

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- a. **Period.** The software is time-sensitive and may stop running on a date that is defined in the software.
- b. **Notice.** You may receive periodic reminder notices of this date through the software.
- c. **Access to data.** You may not be able to access data used in the software when it stops running.
- d. **Digital Content.** If you enter into a comprehensive license agreement for the software promptly following expiration of this Evaluation Agreement, then you may continue to use any digital content

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  - c. remove, minimize, block, or modify any notices of Microsoft or its suppliers in the software;
  - d. use the software in any way that is against the law or to create or propagate malware; or
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4. **BINDING ARBITRATION AND CLASS ACTION WAIVER. This Section applies if you live in (or, if a business, your principal place of business is in) the United States.** If you and Microsoft have a dispute, you and Microsoft agree to try for 60 days to resolve it informally. If you and Microsoft can't, you and Microsoft agree to **binding individual arbitration before the American Arbitration Association** under the Federal Arbitration Act ("FAA"), and **not to sue in court in front of a judge or jury**. Instead, a neutral arbitrator will decide. **Class action lawsuits, class-wide arbitrations, private attorney-general actions**, and any other proceeding where someone acts in a representative capacity **are not allowed**; nor is combining individual proceedings without the consent of all parties.
